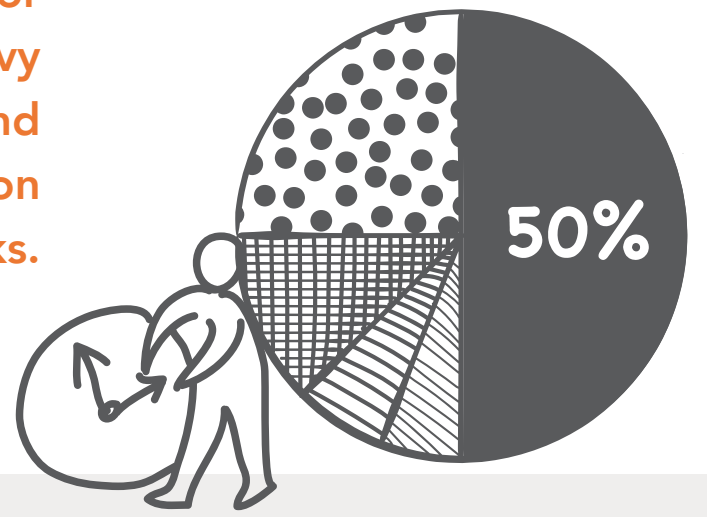


DO YOU WISH YOU HAD MORE TIME FOR THE WORK YOU LOVE?

 You're fairly certain most of your time is spent answering emails.

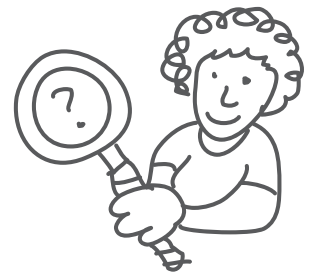
 Half the morning has disappeared while you were looking for documents in the filing cabinets.
